After a fantastic show we return to our hotel, then travel the short distance to **The Star Casino Harvest Buffet** for dinner.

Positioned in a beautiful bush setting in Jervis Bay, the museum enjoys a waterfront location on Currambene Creek and the complex includes a large recreation area with native gardens, a mangrove boardwalk, fish feeding pond, boathouse and historic buildings. The museum features a world-renowned collection of maritime artefacts and navigational and surveying instruments. The Museum exhibits a range of nautical equipment, models, photographs, paintings, drawings and objects relating to the history and heritage of the Jervis Bay area. This afternoon we make our way back to the South Coast, arriving late afternoon. *(Breakfast in hotel, lunch at Jervis Bay Heritage Museum)*
